General Show Terms:

The terms for the show are governed by the rules and regulations set forth in the current official handbook of the AQHA, NRHA, NCHA and FEI

AQHA European Experience Special Conditions -

Eligible for the AQHA classes are registered American Quarter Horses. If an exhibitor placed in the top two(2) in any AQHA class at the 2010 European Championship finals, such exhibitor shall be ineligible to compete in the same class at the Experience. Such exhibitor however is eligible to compete in any other class. If a horse placed in the top two (2) in any halter class at the 2010 European Championship finals, such horse shall be ineligible to compete in any halter class at the Experience. If an exhibitor placed in the top two (2) in any halter class at the 2010 European Championship finals, such exhibitor shall be ineligible to compete in any halter class with a horse of the same sex. Novice exhibitors are allowed to compete with non-owned horses in novice division classes only. The recorded owner retains the ability to show the horse in any other class other than the same class as the novice exhibitor.

CRI: See the special form and note that all exhibitors must present their entry to there national equestrian association! **Exhibitors may** only take part in this class when the registration came from the respective national equestrian association. A registration which was sent to the organizer/showoffice only is not sufficient. Basically all horses must be registered with the FEI. Alien horses must have a FEI passport, domestic horses a FEI or carnet SIRE. Vaccinations must be recorded in the FEI-/Equidenpass, a record in a separate vaccination pass is not sufficient.

Doping

 By signing the entry form the exhibitor respectively horse owner agrees to a horse doping test by urine analysis or blood test.
§ 441 AQHA Rule Book 2011, the doping rules of the FN, apply accordingly as to where no foreign substances are allowed.
In case of positive test results the exhibitor respectively horse owner has to bear the costs.
The respective horse/exhibitor combination will be disqualified retroactive and has to return all cash and non-cash prizes and all rankings.
In addition the organizer reserves the right of further disciplinary actions/sanctions against the particular horse/exhibitor combination or horse owner.

1. Entries per fax or e-mail (scanned copy of entry form with signature) will only be accepted when certified within three (3) days by remittance of the entry fees. **The organizer reserves the right not to accept late entries in general or specific classes.**

2. The exhibitors/horse owner acknowledges this show bill as well as the terms of the event when sending the entry form.

3. The organizer reserves the right to change the show bill prior to the entry deadline, to reschedule the event or to cancel the event by returning payments made when necessitated by special circumstances.

4. There is no contractual relationship between the organizer and the visitors, horse owners and exhibitors. Any joint liability for theft and injury on humans and animals is excluded. Every horse owner and exhibitor when submitting the entry form subjects himself to the instructions and directions of the organizer and the show director and accepts the rules of the AQHA and the NRHA, NCHA, as well as the FFE/FEI. So does every companion and visitor when entering the site.

5. The organizer is not responsible for any mail lost.

6. Each horse must be covered by liability insurance. The horses must be free from contagious disease and must come from a stable where contagious disease is unknown. All horses participating at the show must be immunized at the time of the show especially immunized against influenza. The horse owners must be able to proof immunization by presenting the vaccination record to the show office on request.
